

Web Access Guide

Process for Obtaining Access to the Joint CB Defense Research Program (JCBDRP) Website

Intent

- Ensure information security and protection of potential proprietary information. To accomplish this, only the Department of Defense (DoD) Laboratory Commanders (LC) or their Empowered Staff (ES)—defined as those authorized to act on behalf of the LC—can provide the names of individuals within their organization needing website access.

(Note: DoD Laboratories include DoD FFRDCs.)

Directions for LC/Empowered Staff to Request Website Access for PIs

- The Service LC (or ES) sends an e-mail request to the USAMRMC Partnership Support Directorate (PSD) staff. The e-mail should include the name, telephone number, and e-mail address for each individual for whom access is being requested. The e-mail should clearly distinguish a Principal Investigator (PI) from a LC/empowered staff member since the level of access is different for each group.

- USAMRMC PSD will arrange for an e-mail acknowledgement to be sent to the new user that will include instructions on accessing the JCBDRP website and information related to use of the website. The JCBDRP website address is: <https://jcbdrp.amedd.army.mil/>
- Individuals entering the website for first time must establish their personal password. At this time, the individual will be presented with a nondisclosure statement that must be accepted prior to gaining access to the site.
